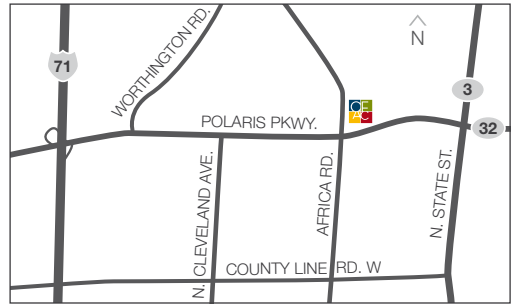

PAYMENT AND INSURANCE.

Payment is required at the beginning of each office visit. We accept personal checks, VISA, MasterCard, cash and most insurance plans. It is extremely important that you bring your insurance cards to your appointment so that we have the necessary and correct information to file all primary and secondary claims for you.

We do our best to understand the various insurance providers and plans. However, it is your responsibility to obtain referrals and determine if we are a provider of your plan. We also accept Medicare and will bill your secondary insurance when needed. Remember, complete payment is ultimately your responsibility.
