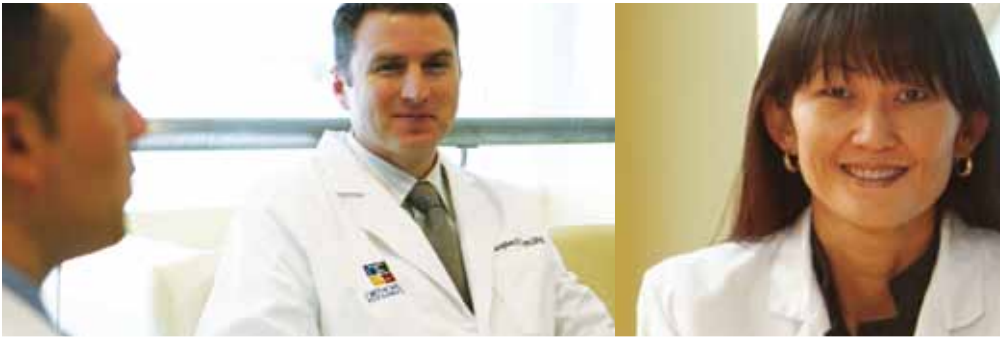

BOARD CERTIFIED SPECIALTY - PODIATRIC SURGERY

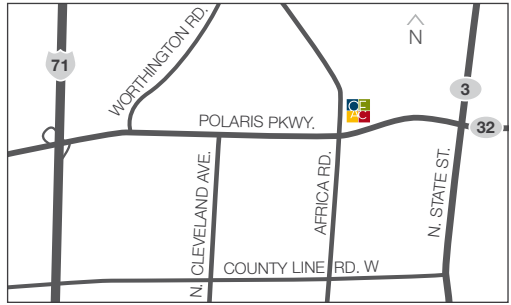
