Inclement weather: If a participant is unable to attend due to inclement weather (Level 3), a refund of the registration fee minus \$20.00 administrative charge will be issued.

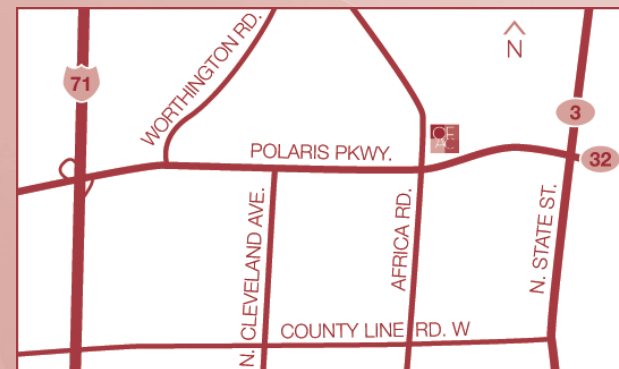
